

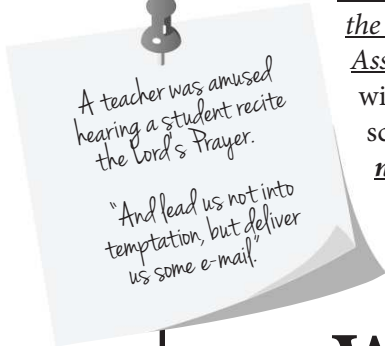
FRIDAY FACTS

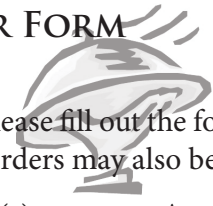
