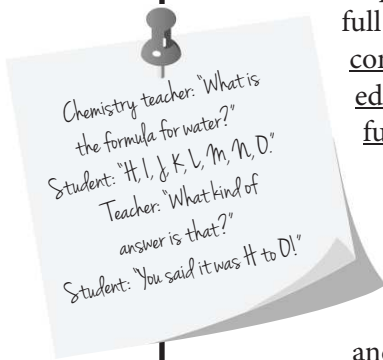


FRIDAY FACTS

FROM THE PRINCIPAL...

One of the most comforting truths of Scripture is that Jesus, our Savior, understands our struggles. Isaiah 53:3 describes Him as “a man of sorrows, acquainted with grief.” Jesus didn’t merely observe human suffering from a distance—He entered into it. He faced hunger, rejection, betrayal, and the weight of unimaginable sorrow. In the Garden of Gethsemane, He prayed with anguish, fully aware of the pain He would endure on the cross. 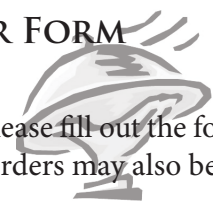

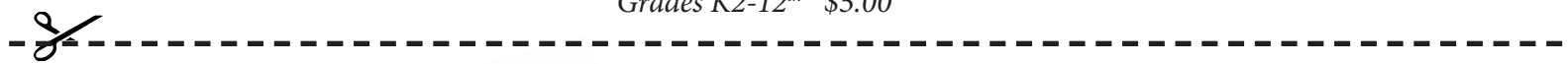
