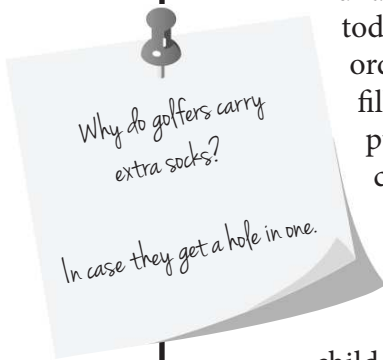


# FRIDAY FACTS
