changes to schedules and procedures that take place during camp. Please carefully read the attached letter that details how camp affects daily school activities. **Just a reminder**

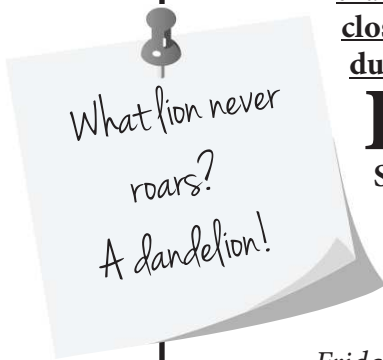
**that the cafeteria will be closed to the academy during this time.**
