We will be doing hearing and eye testing for all elementary students the week of March 31-April 4.

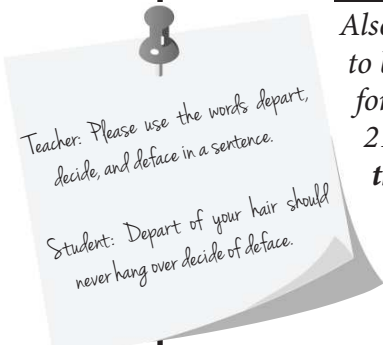
We will be on Spring Break from April 7-14 so there will be no classes for the academy. Classes will resume on April 15.

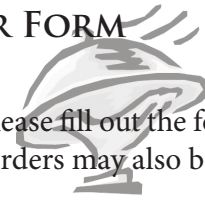
