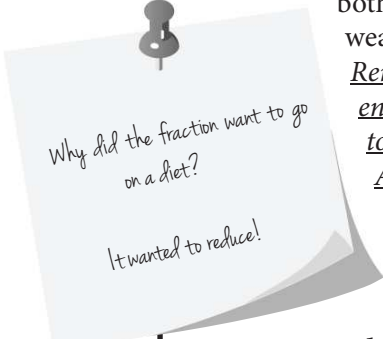


# FRIDAY FACTS

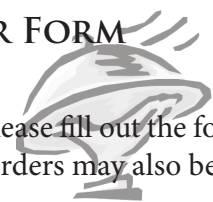

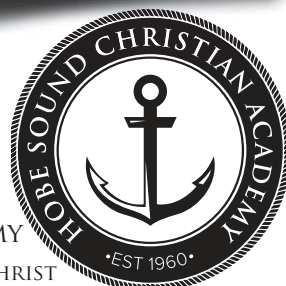
